



3v3 WORLD TOUR RANKINGS RULES

- Your team will receive points according to the “Rankings Explanation”
 - Divisions U6 - U8 are Open (Silver) divisions
 - Divisions U9 and up offer both a Silver and a Gold division
 - Silver divisions will be awarded (x 1) the amount of points
 - Gold divisions will be awarded (x 2) the amount of points
 - Local tournaments will be awarded (x 1) the amount of points
 - 3v3 World Cup will be awarded (x 3) the amount of points
 - The total number of teams in your original division will decide the number you will multiply the total rankings points with

DIVISIONS THAT ARE NOT COMBINED

SCENARIO 1:

Your team is a U11 Girls Gold team and you win a true U11 Girls Gold division with 4 teams in a local tournament. These will be your rankings points:

1. 60 points for 1st place
2. (x 1) for a local tournament
3. (x 2) for Gold division
4. (x 1) for 1 - 4 teams
5. Total points: 120 (60 x 1 x 2 x 1 = 120)

SCENARIO 2:

Your team is a U13 Boys Silver team and you come 2nd in a true U13 Boys Silver division with 12 teams in the 3v3 World Cup. These will be your rankings points:

1. 45 points for 2nd place
2. (x 3) for a 3v3 World Cup tournament
3. (x 1) for a Silver division
4. (x 1.3) for 11 - 15 teams
5. Total points: 175.5 points (45 x 3 x 1 x 1.3 = 175.5)

COMBINED DIVISIONS

RULES FOR COMBINED DIVISIONS

- If your team signed up as a Silver team, you will still be considered a Silver team when receiving the rankings points. (Exception: See Scenario 4 & 5)
- If your team signed up as a Gold team, you will still be considered a Gold team when receiving the rankings points
- If two different age groups (both silver) are combined, the division is considered a Silver division
- The total number of teams in your original division will decide the number you will multiply the total rankings points with

SCENARIO 1:

There are not enough teams in the U9 Girls Gold division and your team (U9 Girls Gold team) is combined with the U10 Girls Gold division in a local tournament.

Your team comes in 3rd place in total (1st place among the U9 Girls Gold teams) with 8 teams in total (3 teams in the U9 Girls division). These will be your rankings points:

1. 60 points for 1st place among the U9 Girls Gold teams
2. (x 1) for a local tournament
3. (x 2) for a Gold division
4. (x 1) for 1 – 4 teams (in your true age group, which had 3 teams)
5. Total points: 120 points (60 x 1 x 2 x 1 = 120)

SCENARIO 2:

There are not enough teams in the U13 Boys Silver division and your team (U13 Boys Silver team) is combined with the U13 Boys Gold Division in a local tournament.

Your team comes in 5th place in total (2nd place among the U13 Boys Silver teams) with 6 teams in total (2 teams in the U13 Boys Silver division). These will be your ranking points:

1. 45 points for 2nd place among the U13 Boys Silver teams
2. (x 1) for a local tournament
3. (x 1) for a Silver division
4. (x 1) for 1 – 4 teams (in your true age group, which had 2 teams)
5. Total points: 45 points (45 x 1 x 1 x 1 = 45)

SCENARIO 3:

There are not enough teams in the U8 Girls Open division and your team (U8 Girls Open team) is combined with the U9 Girls Gold Division in a local tournament.

Your team comes in 4th place in total (1st place among the U8 Girls Open teams) with 6 teams in total (3 teams in the U8 Girls Open division). These will be your ranking points:

1. 60 points for 1st place among the U8 Girls Open teams
2. (x 1) for a local tournament
3. (x 1) for an Open (Silver) division
4. (x 1) for 1 – 4 teams (in your true age group, which had 3 teams)
5. Total points: 60 points (60 x 1 x 1 x 1 = 60)

SCENARIO 4:

Your team is a U12 Boys Gold team and you decide to play up in the U13 Boys Gold division, even if we have a U12 boys Gold division to offer at a local tournament. Since you decide to play up even if we have a U12 Boys Gold division for your team, you will be awarded the points you receive in the U13 Boys Gold division. This could have a positive or a negative impact on your rankings points. The U12 Boys Gold division has 4 teams and the U13 Boys Gold division has 8 teams.

Your team comes in 1st place in total with 6 teams in total. These will be your rankings points:

1. 60 points for 1st place in the U13 Boys Gold division
2. (x 1) for a local tournament
3. (x 2) for a Gold division
4. (x 1.2) for 8 - 10 teams (in total)
5. Total points: 144 points ($60 \times 1 \times 2 \times 1.2 = 144$). If you would have won the U12 Boys Gold division with 4 teams you would have received 120 points ($60 \times 1 \times 2 \times 1$)

SCENARIO 5:

Your team is a U12 Boys Gold team and you decide to play up in the U13 Boys Gold division, even if we have a U12 boys Gold division to offer at a local tournament. Since you decide to play up even if we have a U12 Boys Gold division for your team, you will be awarded the points you receive in the U13 Boys Gold division. This could have a positive or a negative impact on your rankings points. The U12 Boys Gold division has 8 teams and the U13 Boys Gold division has 4 teams.

Your team comes in 2nd place in total with 4 teams in total. These will be your rankings points:

1. 45 points for 2nd place in the U13 Boys Gold division
2. (x 1) for a local tournament
3. (x 2) for a Gold division
4. (x 1) for 1 - 4 teams (in total)

Total points: 90 points ($45 \times 1 \times 2 \times 1 = 90$). If you would have won the U12 Boys Gold division with 8 teams you would have received 144 points ($60 \times 1 \times 2 \times 1.2$)
